PHARMACY SET TO STAY IN CORRIGAN UNTIL MID-FEB.

The pharmacy in the Corrigan, originally set to move to a patio home on Gazebo Circle during the renovation, will stay in its current location until mid-February.

The delay on relocation to 9850 Gazebo Circle is due to the timing of permits.

Like the rest of the Corrigan building, the pharmacy will be renovated during the spring. The updates will include a privacy wall in front of the pick-up window made of art glass. The artist is currently working on designs to show the contractors.

"I'm very excited about the renovation," said pharmacist, Bill Pepper. "PVN is so generous to give us a nice new pharmacy and I look forward to seeing it completed."

When the pharmacy does reach its new home on Gazebo Circle, it will accept walk-ins and offer same-day delivery, as necessary.

WHAT TO EXPECT WHILE THEY'RE CONSTRUCTING

A Guide to Construction at PVN

FEBRUARY 1 - 5

- Contractors will work on the drainage system for the Hawthorne garage.
- Electrical work will continue in the Hawthorne garage.
- Beams will continue to be drilled in the Corrigan dining room.
- Clean-up of the demolition of Classroom 1 and its walking path will continue this week. Please avoid this area and the adjacent walking path. These areas will be closed for the remainder of the Corrigan renovation.
- Contractors will begin to frame the walls in the Spa Café.
- The gatehouse framing will be covered with a weather-resistant material, called exterior veneer.
- Programs will be held in the Corrigan Activity Room located in the hallway of the executive offices.
