- The Hawthorne garage:
 - The initial concrete pour for the first floor was delayed. It was rescheduled this week.
 - This delay will not affect other concrete pours on the first floor.
 - Waterproofing garage walls will be complete by the end of the week.
- The Corrigan building:
 - The timeline for demolition was extended until further notice.
 - HVAC and electrical work begins in the Spa Café and corridor areas.
- The gatehouse:
 - Masonry brickwork on the exterior continues.
- Programs continue to be held in the Corrigan activity room.
