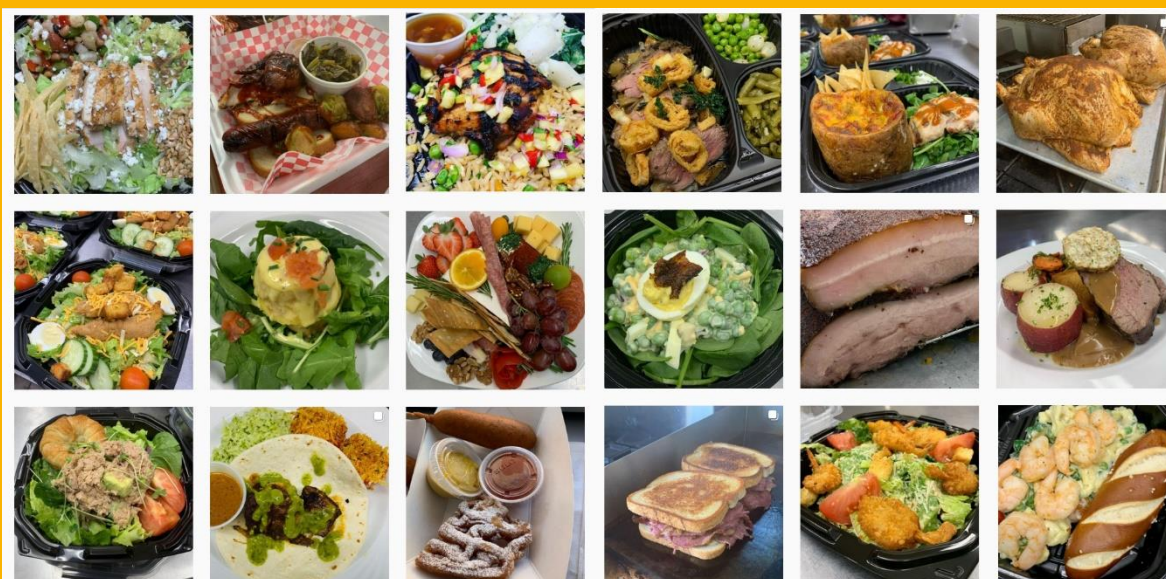

CHRISTMAS COMES EARLY FOR PLANO PROJECT

The Bond Anticipation Notes (BANS) for The Outlook at Windhaven in Plano priced this week. At over \$20 million, this is the largest BANS transaction in the history of non-profit senior living. The BANS generated a great deal of interest from investors and were fully committed within 45 minutes of their offering. Because of the high interest level, the BANS priced a full percentage point lower than expected at 10%, saving the project \$1.2 million.

Due to the diligent work of many, including our partners at Ziegler and Greystone this is a milestone moment for our organization. We anticipate closing on the property December 23 - just in time for Christmas!
