ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GIRLS BRING CHEER AND SWEETS TO COVID PATIENTS

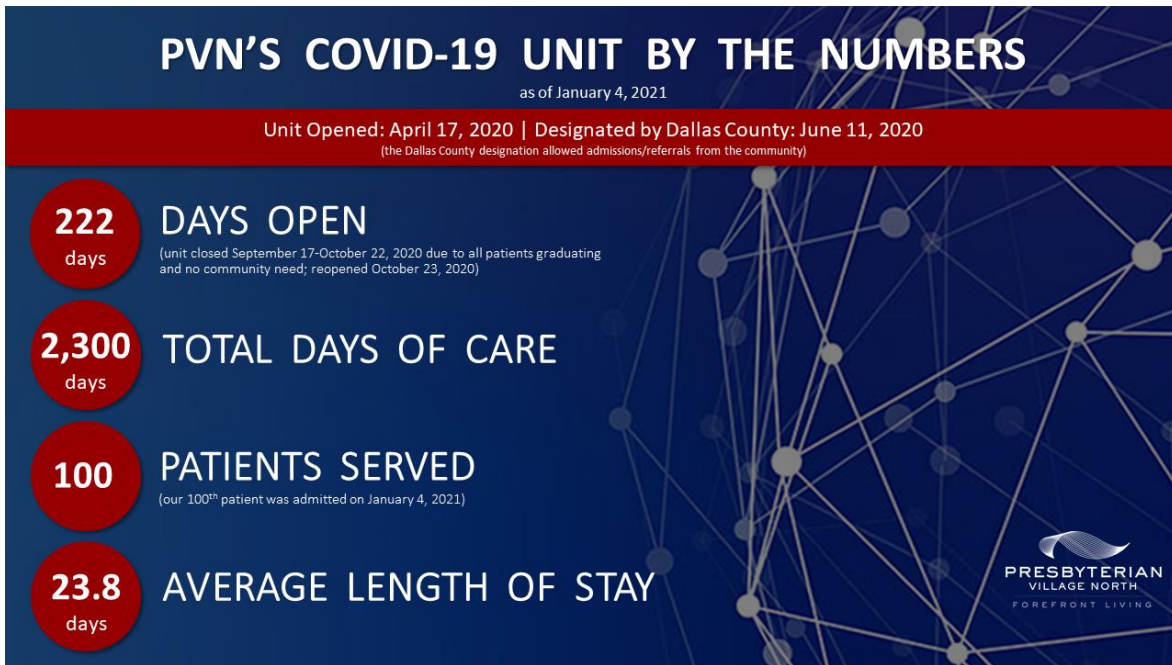

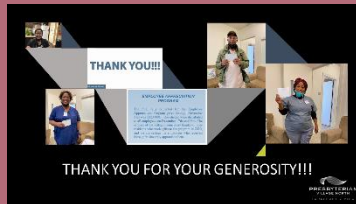


Three vaccination clinics have taken place at PVN since Jan. 5, with a fourth scheduled for tomorrow.

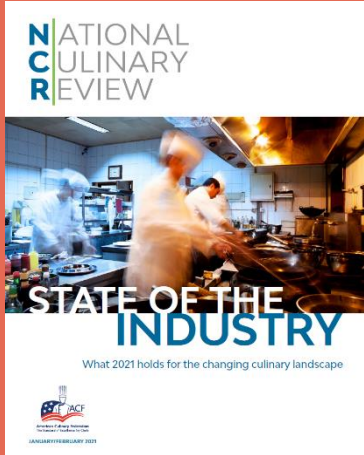
